- Ensure schools within Detroit Public Schools Community District are activating all components of Unified Champion Schools Unified Sports, inclusive youth leadership and whole-school engagement.
- Develop community partnerships with organizations outside of DPSCD to enhance programming for students and staff.
- Oversee messaging and marketing efforts related to Unified Champion Schools, Unified Sports, and all other aspects of Special Olympics inclusive messaging.
- Ensure the program is in compliance with all regulations, general rules and policy originating from SOMI, Inc., Special Olympics International and other 501 (c) 3 governing bodies and completes all reports related to UCS programming.
- Facilitate the development & cultivation of relationships, funds, sponsors and in-kind resources.
- Perform other duties as assigned, which may require attendance at events held in the evenings or on weekends.
